# • Type of condition

- Categorization of condition

#### Onset

-When did it start

#### Etiology/Cause

- -Infectious agent
- Physical agent
- Internal failure
- Congenital

## • Anatomical location

- -Which anatomical structure
- Proximal, distal, medial, lateral, central, peripheral, superior, inferior, anterior, posterior

## Laterality

- Right side or left side
- -Bilaterally or unilateral

## Severity

-Mild, moderate, or severe

#### • Environmental factors

- Smoking
- -Geographic location

## • Time parameters

- -Intermittent/paroxysmal
- Recurring
- -Acute or Chronic
- -Postoperative, post delivery

# • Comorbidities or complications

- Diabetes with neuropathic joint
- -Intracranial injury

## Manifestations

- -Paralysis
- -Loss of consciousness

## • Healing level

- Routine healing, delayed healing, non-union, malunion
- Findings and symptoms
  - -Fever
  - -Hypoglycemia/hyperglycemia
  - -Wheezing

#### • External causes

- -Motor vehicles, injury locations
- Assault, accidental, work related, intentional self-harm

#### • Type of encounter

 Initial encounter, subsequent encounter, encounter for condition sequel, routine evaluation, administrative encounter

Poorly Specified Coding - Is coding that does not fully define important parameters of the patient condition that could otherwise be defined given information available to the observer (clinician) and the coder.
