Documentation

Distinguish between:	Document any specific:
Cause of trisomy 21, such as nonmosaicism (meiotic nondisjunction), mosaicism (mitotic nondisjunction), or translocation.	Manifestations or conditions associated with Down's syndrome, such as cardiac, GI, endocrine, etc.
Document association:	
Physical conditions and the degree of mental retardation	

ICD-10 Codes

Below are a few example ICD-10 codes selected to help display how the clinical features of this condition align with the documentation requirements of ICD-10.

Q90.0	Trisomy 21, nonmosaicism (meiotic nondisjunction)
Q90.1	Trisomy 21, mosaicism (mitotic nondisjunction)
Q90.2	Trisomy 21, translocation
Q90.9	Down syndrome, unspecified
G40.A09	Absence epileptic syndrome, not intractable, w/o stat epi
F80.89	Other developmental disorders of speech and language
