### Documentation

Differentiate between:	Non-infectious gastroenteritis or colitis due to radiation:
Gastroenteritis vs. isolated diarrhea,	Document the primary malignancy for
colitis, or enteritis	which the radiation treatment is targeted
Infectious etiology – infectious gastroenteritis	Infectious Etiology:
Document the infectious agent if known	Document the infectious agent, and indicate if it is drug resistant
Non-infectious etiology	$\sim$
Indicate the cause; if toxic gastroenteritis and colitis, document the toxic agent, if know; if allergic and dietetic gastroenteritis and colitis, document the type of food allergy, if known	FOR CO MEMBERS ONLY

#### ICD-10 Codes

Below are a few example ICD-10 codes selected to help display how the clinical features of this condition align with the documentation requirements of ICD-10.

- A09 Infectious gastroenteritis and colitis, unspecified
- K52.0 Gastroenteritis and colitis due to radiation
- K52.1 Toxic gastroenteritis and colitis
- K52.2 Allergic and dietetic gastroenteritis and colitis
