Documentation

Note Site of Infection:	Candidiasis of Urinary Tract:
Urethritis or cystitis	Must be specifically documented
If Urethritis:	Specify:
Note any abscess, if present	If urinary tract infection is occurring in a neonate
Cystitis:	Identify:
Acute or chronic, presence or absence of hematuria, if secondary to irradiation, or specifically trigonitis	Infectious agent, if known
