### Documentation

<b>Document the specific type of emphysema:</b>	<b>Clearly document if the conditions presents the types of emphysema:</b>
Unilateral pulmonary (MacLeod's syndrome), panlobular or centrilobular emphysema	Compensatory, interstitial, mediastinal, neonatal interstitial, surgical subcutaneous, or traumatic subcutaneous
<b>Indicate if due to:</b>	<b>Document tobacco or tobacco products:</b>
Inhalation of chemicals, gases, fumes, or vapors	History of tobacco use, exposure to environmental smoke, or occupational exposure to environmental tobacco smoke
<b>Indicate if condition presents with:</b>	
Chronic (obstructive) bronchitis or emphysematous (chronic) Bronchitis	

### ICD-10 Codes

Below are a few example ICD-10 codes selected to help display how the clinical features of this condition align with the documentation requirements of ICD-10.

J43.0	Unilateral pulmonary emphysema [MacLeod's syndrome]
J43.1	Panlobular emphysema
J43.2	Centrilobular emphysema
J43.8	Other emphysema
F17.210	Nicotine dependence, cigarettes, uncomplicated
