Documentation

Location of ulcer	Whether or not ulcer if bleeding or perforated
Acute or Chronic	Note:
Etiology of Ulcer	Encounter is for initial active treatment, subsequent treatment, or for sequela

Instructional Notes in Tabular:

“Code first, for adverse effects, the nature of the adverse effect”

Tabular states – appropriate 7th character is to be added to ICD-10-CM category T39 codes

ICD-10 Codes

K25.9 - Gastric ulcer, unspecified as acute or chronic, without hemorrhage or perforation.

T39.315A – Adverse effect of propionic acid derivatives, initial encounter

ICD-9 Codes

531.90 – Gastric ulcer, unspecified as acute or chronic, without mention of hemorrhage or perforation, without mention of obstruction.

E935.6 - Antirheumatics (antiphlogistics) causing adverse effect in therapeutic use.
