Documentation

Type: Migraine, abdominal migraine, cluster, tension, hypnic, trigeminal autonomic cephalgia, vascular, new daily persistent headache, primary thunderclap headache Histamine, short lasting unilateral neuralgiform headache w/ conjunctival injection and tearing, hemicranias continua	Temporal Factors: Acute Chronic Periodic or episodic Persistent Recurring
Severity: Irtractable, not intractable, with or without status migranosus	Contributing Factors: Trauma, spinal epidural, drug induced, cough, sexual activity, exertion
Symptoms, findings manifestations: With or without aura, hemiplegia, cerebral infraction, ophthalmoplegia, stabbing, cyclical vomiting	Associated Condition: Pregnancy Menstruation
