Documentation

Specify the heart failure as:	Indicate specifically:
Systolic, diastolic, or combined systolic and diastolic heart failure	Left heart failure
Characterize the heart failure as:	Indicate if heart failure is:
Acute, chronic, or acute on chronic	Complicating pregnancy, occurring following surgery, or due to hypertension, with or w/out chronic kidney disease

ICD-10 Codes

Below are a few example ICD-10 codes selected to help display how the clinical features of this condition align with the documentation requirements of ICD-10.

I50.1 Left ventricular failure	I50.33 Acute on chronic diastolic(congestive)hrt fail
I50.21 Acute systolic (congestive)heart failure	I50.33 Acute on chronic diastolic (congestive)hrt fail
