Documentation

Site or involved joint of the osteoarthritis:	Secondary osteoarthritis of the hip:
Hip, knee, carpometacarpal joint, shoulder, elbow, wrist, hand, ankle and foot, or spine.	Specify if the condition is due to hip dysplasia
Specify:	Indicate the laterality:
Primary or secondary osteoarthritis	Right, left, or bilateral
Secondary arthritis:	Polyosteoarthritis:
Specify the cause of the condition (post-traumatic, other specified cause)	Specify if primary generalized osteoarthritis, Heberden's nodes with arthropathy, Bouchard's nodes with arthropathy, secondary multiple arthritis, erosive osteoarthritis, or other polyosteoarthritis
