Documentation

Type of condition: Tubotympanic, Atticoantral, Mucoïd	Environmental factors Smoking - Exposure to environmental tobacco smoke - History of tobacco use
Onset: Acute/Chronic	Occupational exposure to environmental tobacco smoke, tobacco dependence, tobacco use
Etiology/Cause: Measles, Influenza, Influenza, Allergies	Time parameters: Recurring, acute or chronic
Laterality: Right side or left side, Bilateral or unilateral	Comorbidities or complications With spontaneous rupture of the tympanic membrane (TM)
	Manifestations: Serous, suppurative
